## Ibis Slipi Hotel, Jakarta, Indonesia

Located on Jl. S. Parman, the main road leading from the city of Jakarta to the Soekarno-Hatta International Airport, the 15-storey high Ibis Hotel is an asset to the city's skyline.

PT BAM Decorient Indonesia completed the 58-metre tower a month ahead of schedule.

### Scope of work

The Ibis Hotel stands spaciouly on 5,000 square metres of land, with a two-storey podium containing the lobby, shops, restaurants, meeting rooms, a garden bar, swimming pools and offices for staff and management. It also boasts two-storey parking garage and is equipped with a sewage treatment plant, utility machinery and various systems supporting efficient hotel operations. The finishing touch, on the roof of the 345-room hotel, is a helicopter pad.



### Construction

Constructed with top-quality materials, the foundation comprises 327 pieces of 500-millimetre Frankipiles. The podium, basement and the L-shaped tower were constructed with a mixture of post-tensioned and traditionally reinforced concrete structures. Curtain walls made from prefabricated aluminium and glass panels cover the outer part of the hotel.
