

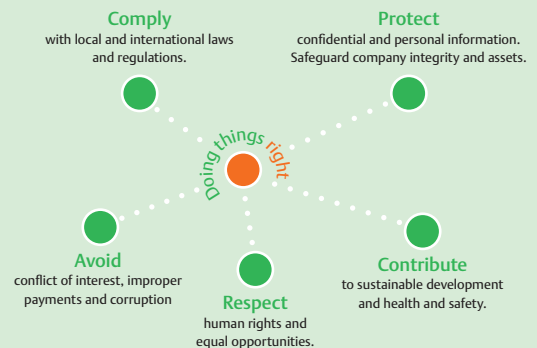


Corporate Responsibility

The Corporate Responsibility (CR) policy of BAM International provides guidance to our business conduct and to our effects on the environment and social wellbeing. At the same time it ensures that our values and behaviour are aligned with the expectations and needs of our stakeholders and the society as a whole. This policy is also to ensure our 'duty of care' responsibilities towards our employees and persons affected by our activities.

Our Corporate Responsibility policy is in compliance with the UN - Universal Declaration of Human Rights and the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD) guidelines for multinational enterprises. We consider it important to have a culture of doing the right thing, taking responsibility and working together in a transparent way. These principles have been laid down in our Code of Conduct. Any suspected misconduct can be reported through 'speak up' to ensure that we conduct our business in a transparent manner.

Bribery and corruption are prohibited with respect to any person under the control of BAM International as directed in the BAM Bribery and Corruption policy. Our business is conducted in such way that the health, well-being and welfare of all persons involved in, or affected by, our activities are safeguarded as provided for in our Occupational Health & Safety policy. We respect the privacy rights of our staff, clients, suppliers and business partners. We are committed to managing personal data in accordance with the BAM Privacy Policy.
